REFLECTING

Connecting the dots, understanding what we see and hear and read, drawing on research to inform and enlighten, comparing and contrasting information, being professionally curious, seeing the whole picture and its moving parts.



PLANNING

Reading files ahead of meetings/visits/hearings, multi-tasking but also prioritising, building in contingencies, staying organised, managing tensions between competing priorities and needs, know what the 'must haves' are and the 'would likes', knowing the risks, parallel planning.
