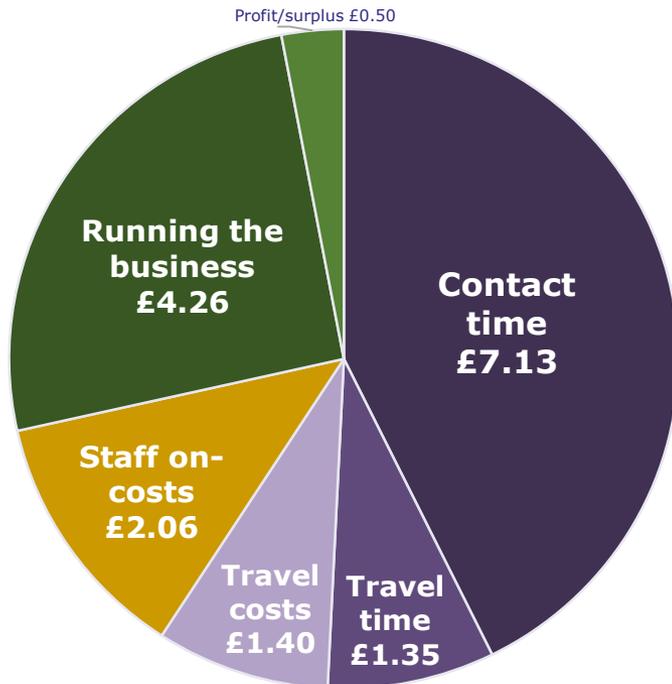
Stability of the state-funded homecare market



- Inadequacy of fees paid vs. costs:
 - ◆ On average prices £2/hour below costs
 - ◆ Providers handing-back contracts to councils
- Difficulty recruiting and retaining workforce:
 - ◆ Demand out-strips available supply
 - ◆ Attraction of self-funding market
- Quality of work patterns and terms & conditions:
 - ◆ Inflexible commissioning; short visits; low pay rates
- Future impact of Brexit

Understanding the costs of care

£16.70/hour minimum price for homecare

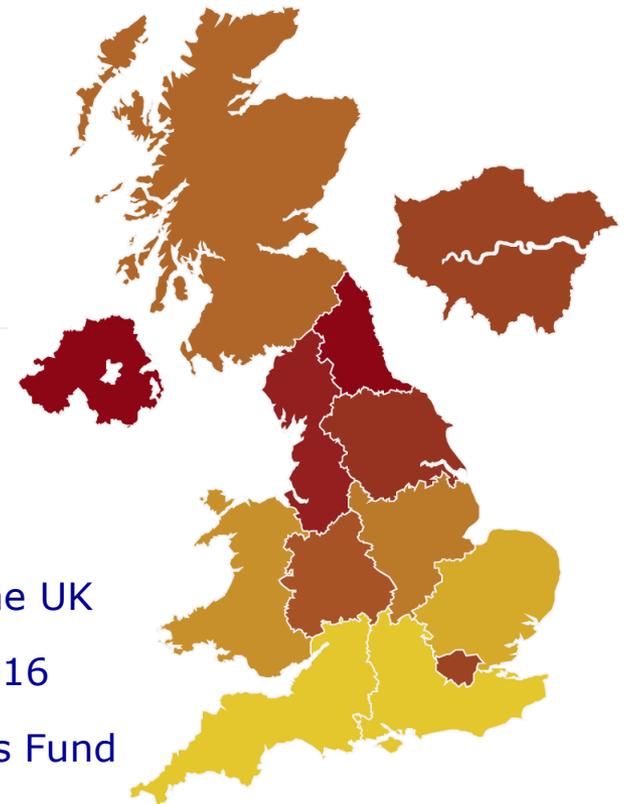
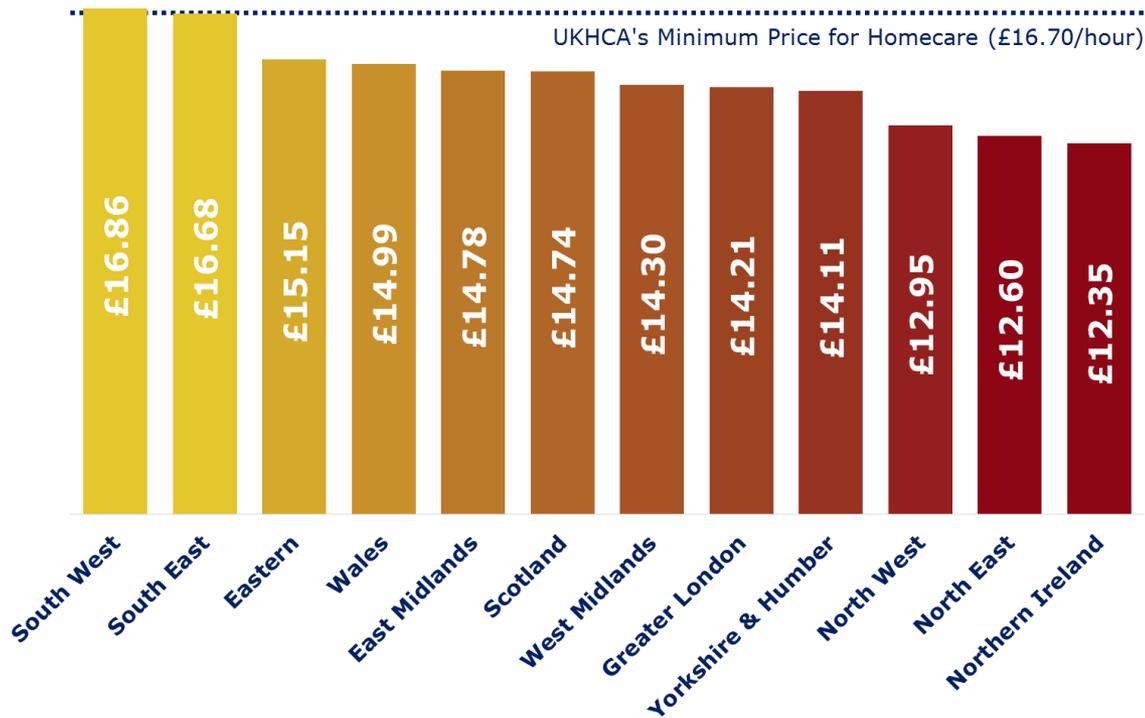


Contact time at NMW or NLW	£7.13
11.4 minutes travel/per contact hour	£1.35
4 miles at £0.35 per mile	£1.40
Employer's NI (9.5% of gross pay)	£0.81
Holiday pay (12.07% of gross pay)	£1.02
Training time (1.73% of gross pay)	£0.15
Pensions (1.0% of gross pay)	£0.08
Running the business (25.5% total price)	£4.26
Profit/surplus (3.0% total price)	£0.50

Prices councils pay for homecare

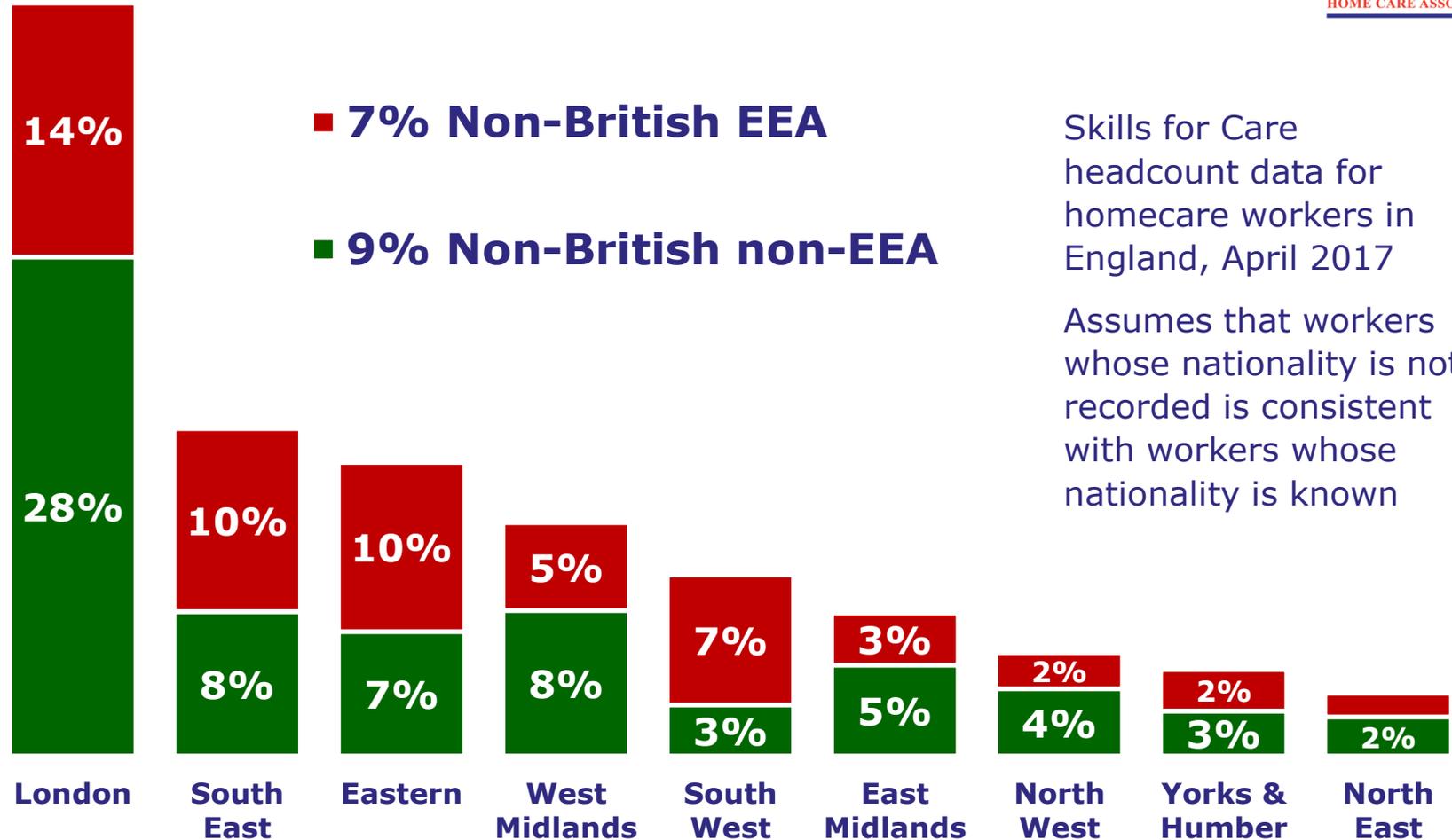


- Freedom of Information enquiry to every council in the UK

Assumes that workers whose nationality is not recorded is consistent with workers whose nationality is known

Potential solutions



- Open, transparent, collaborative cost of care exercises
- Engagement with market before procurement exercises
 - ◆ Avoiding unnecessary costs and unsuitable working patterns
- Design new models of care in economic reality of cost
- Maximise flexibility through Individual Service Funds
- Managing demand through outcome-based commissioning
 - ◆ Get incentives right in payment-by-results mechanisms
